


Stock Screener Tool

1 Go to Find Ideas

To access the value Line Stock ScreenerTool, click the FIND IDEAS tab on the top black menu bar, and click “Screener” on the sub-menu. The Stock ScreenerTool will appear with all available criteria. (Screener criteria are determined by the level of service associated with your subscription).

2 Stock Screener Tool

Once the Stock Screener is open, choose from the screening criteria listed on the left side of the web page. Once you choose screening criteria by clicking on those you desire, the appropriate information will appear on the right side.

Reset criteria to start over. - Points to the 'RESET CRITERIA' button at the top of the screener interface.

A check mark appears when screening criteria is added. To remove screening criteria, click on the check mark. - Points to a checkmark in the 'Company Data' section of the left-hand criteria list.

With your cursor, move the little black rectangular icons within the bar to adjust the numbers. - Points to a slider control for the 'CASH FLOW GROWTH 1 YEAR' criterion.

After choosing your screening criteria you can view the number of matches. - Points to the 'Cumulative matches 170' indicator for the 'COUNTRY OF DOMICILE' criterion.

Click on the tabs to view more options to refine your screen. - Points to the 'Criteria' tab in the 'Results: 88' section.

For some Ranks and Ratings, click which Ranks and Ratings you want. If you choose Industry Rank, you can move the black rectangular icons to adjust your choices from the lowest ranked industries to the highest. - Points to the 'Ranks & Ratings' section in the left-hand criteria list.




